Volunteer Action**

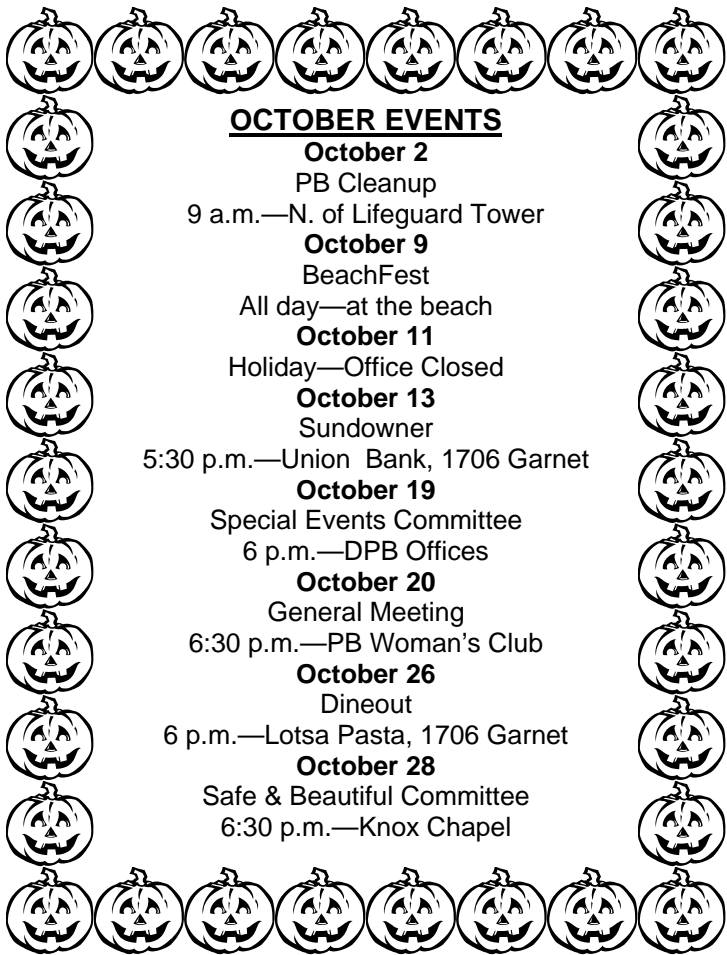
