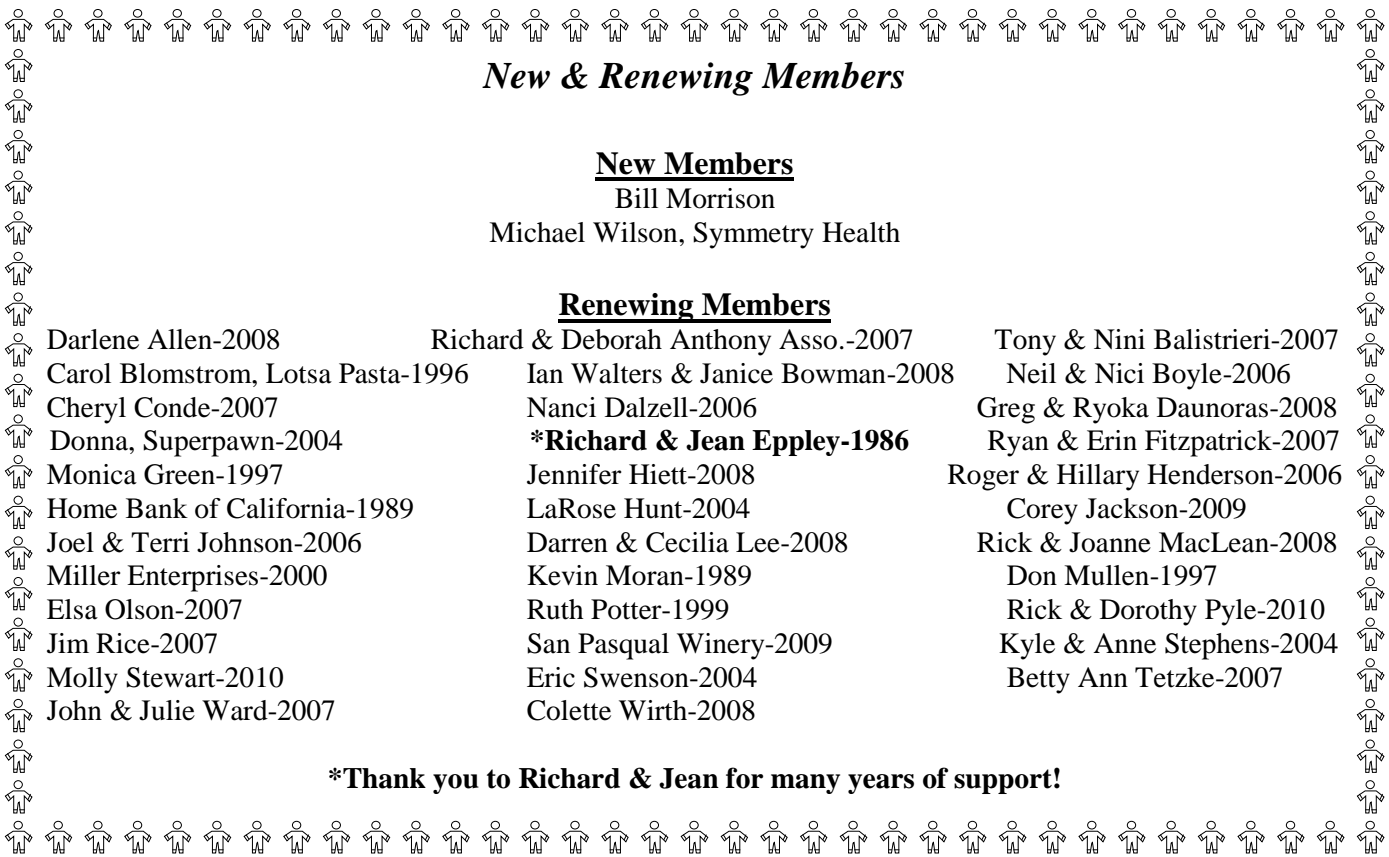
## PB Day at the San Diego County Fair
