LIFE THREATENING OR CRIME IN PROGRESS...DIAL 911!

NEED THE POLICE FOR A NON-EMERGENCY, i.e. a crime not in-progress?

- **Call the police non-emergency line (619) 531-2000.** Ask dispatcher for a Tracking #, and record the date & time in a permanent log. You may need the # to follow-up. **Why call?** Every call creates a statistic that helps the City with hiring needs. Tips: Press * key to bypass recorded messages; add this # in your mobile phone contact list. Your name will be kept private.
- Report unresolved chronic problems, including illegally parked RVs/oversized vehicles to: SDPD Community Relations Officer (CRO) Brandon Broaddus; bbroaddus@pd.sandiego.gov
- Want to start a Neighborhood Watch? Email Marcella Teran: Info@SavePB.org or call CRO Broaddus 858 552-1631. The police say that a Neighborhood Watch can help prevent many crimes from occurring in your neighborhood.



GET IT DONE SAN DIEGO

Many non-emergency problems can be reported through **Get It Done San Diego**.

1. *The key is persistence.* Call Police Non-Emergency (619) 531-2000, report exact address and get Tracking #
2. Keep records in a permanent log (date, time, description, Tracking #).

Noise any time of the day or night from a Neighbor or Business.

If the noise *"is disturbing your peace"*, you have the right to call police non-emergency **(619) 531-2000**. Report the exact address, get Tracking #, and record in a log.

Going on vacation or having your house tented?

Would you like someone to check on an elderly person living alone?

Call the Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol (R.S.V.P) two weeks prior – (858) 552-1737

Problem with a local bar or liquor store, e.g. Noise, public drunkenness, fights, etc.

- Call Police non-emergency (619) 531-2000, give exact address, get Tracking #, log it
- Inform SDPD Vice – call 619-531-2973 or mail to 1401 Broadway, S.D. 92101-5729
- Inform SDPD Community Relations Officer Broaddus bbroaddus@pd.sandiego.gov
- File ABC Complaint: Call Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) – (619) 525-4064 or submit online complaint: <https://www.abc.ca.gov/Forms/PDFCompl.html>

Unpermitted construction, illegal sign or unstable structure in your neighborhood.

Report code violations or dangerous conditions online at:

GRAFFITI on your property or other property.

Photograph it and record location and date. Report it on "Get-It-Done (see above).

Photo will be sent to Graffiti Tracker Database. If you remove it, note that in the report.

SCOOTER Issue or Removal. Report on Get-It-Done App first. This creates a problem statistic with city. Call or text with photos and exact location. ScootScoop: 858 262-1912
