“De Anza Short-Term Improvement” by Jacob Gelfand

Proposal to extend Campland’s lease to 2026 and take over management of the De Anza RV park while also adding 150 more campsites. Removal of the mobile homes currently at De Anza with asbestos abatement for \$3.7 million plus renovations to the site’s pool and clubhouse. Improvements to the bike/pedestrian path. Campland’s funding of these projects would be reimbursed through \$8 million in rent credits.

“Mission Bay Gateway” by Scott Chipman

Seeks to enhance current facilities and bike path while also extending new amenities like pools, sports fields, and restaurant. Protect MB marshland and bird sanctuaries. Recreational destination NE corner of Mission Bay. Website: missionbaygateway.org

“C-3 Alternative Plan” by Rod Meade with introduction by Kristen Victor
