Captain Jerry Hara – Update on Police Dispatch and Communications

Due to sentinel event 8 months ago, the 911 system needed immediate revamping. New January statistics are very successful with 94.9% of 911 calls are answered in less than 10 seconds. With 170 dispatchers, 1.4 million calls are received. However 1200 were unnecessary and unintended "butt dials." The non emergency line number is 531-2000 the average wait is 3 min 25 sec. Text to 911 is not available yet but will be coming soon with the implement of PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point).

Life Guard Ed Harris, Aquatic Emergency Division of Fire Department

Discussion of 911 system going through the Fire Department for Aquatic Emergencies. Mr Harris speaking to delays caused by Fire Department officials answering calls for aquatic emergencies. Out of 9000 water rescues per year, Mr Harris reports that 50/300 callers in aquatic emergencies needed “fire help.” “Don’t need medical aide until the person is rescued out of the water.” Life Guards would like to be called directly through Life Guard Dispatchers. Direct emergency number is 619-221-8800.

Mike Zucchet, General Manager San Diego Municipal Employees Association

Mr Zucchet spoke to the effects of pension reform on city employee retention and recruitment.
