### CRIME IN PROGRESS...DIAL 911!

- **Non-emergency call (619) 531-2000**, Ask for the incident #, write down the date & time in a permanent log. Enter this phone # in your mobile phone contacts.
- **Don't wait until crimes occur, accidents happen, or problems get out of control.** Raise your concerns or **report chronic problems** to our SDPD Community Relations Officer (CRO), Larry Hesselgesser. Email at [lhesselgesse@pd.sandiego.gov](mailto:lhesselgesse@pd.sandiego.gov)
- **Aquatic Emergency?** Call 619-221-8800. This is a direct line to Lifeguard Emergency Services. Enter this number in your cell phone contacts. Or dial 911!

**Report non-emergency problems to the City with your smart phone: graffiti, pothole, street light, traffic signal, storm water, street repair, abandoned vehicle, dead animal and more!** Use the Smart Phone App, "GET IT DONE SAN DIEGO".

**Problem with a local bar or liquor store**, e.g. Noise, public drunkenness, fights, etc.

File complaints with:

**Is there unpermitted construction, noise nuisance, illegal sign, or unstable structure in your neighborhood? Trash and Recycling bins left out all week?** Report these suspected code violations or dangerous conditions to Code Enforcement. Online at [www.sandiego.gov/ced/report#Report](http://www.sandiego.gov/ced/report#Report) --or-- Call (619) 236-5500.

### Do you live next to a noisy vacation rental or party house?

1. *The key is persistence.* Report to the Non-Emergency Number (619) 531-2000.
2. Keep records in a permanent log.
3. Read about the Community Assisted Party Program (CAPP) on the City's website. (Go to [www.sandiego.gov/](http://www.sandiego.gov/) and search for CAPP).

**Is there an illegally parked vehicle on your street**, e.g. Oversized vehicle (2am-6am), high-profile vehicle parked near corner (anytime)? Call (619) 531-2000. **Unresolved Oversize Vehicle parking** – email Officer Larry Hesselgesser at [lhesselgesse@pd.sandiego.gov](mailto:lhesselgesse@pd.sandiego.gov)

### Abandoned or stripped bikes locked to street poles?

File a report using your Smart Phone app, "GET DONE SAN DIEGO". Select New Report – Street - > Traffic Sign then describe the problem - Or - call (619) 527-7500

**Trash or recycling not picked up?** Call 858-492-5055

**Water & Sewer Emergency?** Call 619-515-3525

**Would you like someone to check your home when you are on vacation, having your house tented or to check on an elderly person living alone?**

Call the Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol (R.S.V.P) two weeks prior - (858)-552-1737

**GRAFFITI on your property or other property?** Photograph it and record the location and date. With permission of the property owner, remove with GOOF-OFF or paint. File a report using your Smart Phone app, "GET DONE SAN DIEGO" – or -- online at [www.sandiego.gov](http://www.sandiego.gov).
