FEATURE PRESENTATION: SDPD NEIGHBORHOOD POLICING DIVISION

Captain Scott Wahl, Lt. Charles Lara, Lt. David Bautista

Neighborhood Policing Division formed to deal with chronic quality-of-life community issues. Previous Homeless Outreach and Psychiatric Emergency Response Teams serve under one chain of command now. Outreach efforts attempt to connect homeless individuals with services including shelter, Hepatitis A vaccinations, mental health or addiction treatment, and other medical aid. The enforcement arm of this division addresses neighborhood concerns, repeat offenders, and collaborates with other departments and organizations to clean debris from streets, canyons, parks, and highways. 60 people are currently working in this division.
